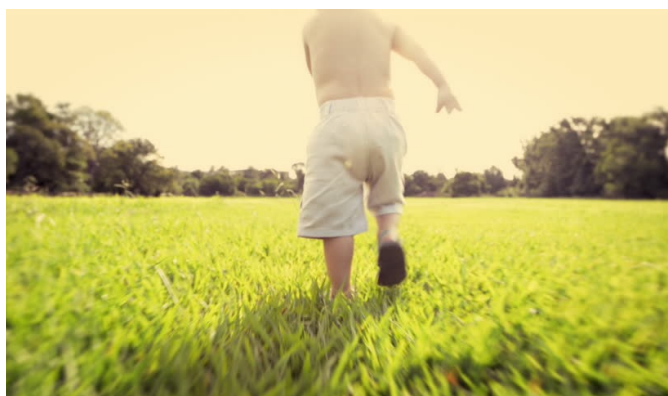

God's Love and Plan for Women in Haiti

As God was forming a team of women in Haiti, He guided me to a nurse practitioner in the US, Teresa Lum, who had been on mission trips to Haiti. I was thankful for her medical expertise and practical experience from her travels. In Haiti we worked with Marie Lucie, a national missionary and translator, Olga, the director of Centre Lumiere, the domestic school where the seminar took place, and our friend Tina Nunemaker, who was the former director of the Greencastle PMI center. God brought together the skills needed to accomplish this mission and I was blessed to work with these godly, gracious women.

We arrived in the capital city of Port au Prince and were driven 5 hours South West to the coastal town of Les Cayes, a town that experienced the brunt of hurricane Matthew as it passed over in 2016. We were hosted by Tina and her family who are missionaries with Reciprocal Ministries. Her husband, Lee, gave us an orientation Saturday morning to help us get acquainted and

know how best to interact with this different culture. We also met the amazing team God had prepared.

Our seminar was Monday through Thursday and included teaching on reproduction, abortion, abortion recovery and God's value of life. Teresa and I shared our stories of faith and how God helped us through areas of struggle. The women were very attentive and moved by these stories and I believe God used them to soften their hearts, helping them feel comfortable to ask intimate questions and receive what we had to share. Close to 100 women of various ages attended each day. At the end of the seminar a Pastor's wife asked how they could have this seminar presented at their churches. We were blessed to hear that desire and are now in prayer about what else God might have in the future for us in Haiti.
