After reflecting on the first months of 2025, I'm reminded of a client who first visited us last fall. An ultrasound showed no intrauterine pregnancy, so she was sent to the ER. After several blood tests and another ultrasound, her physician suspected an ectopic pregnancy

(one outside of the uterus, sometimes fatal if not treated). After more complications, she needed emergency surgery where a Fallopian tube and ovary were removed. Returning here last month, her ultrasound now showed a normal pregnancy. Praise God! She said she would have never known something was wrong, but because she was seen at PMI sooner than at her OB office, she was able to be diagnosed earlier, potentially saving her life. We could not help clients like these without your continued prayers and support. We are extremely grateful and blessed by each of you.
