This past August, I heard Roland Warren (CareNet CEO) speak about something that gripped me. Something that never crossed my mind before, but since that day, I have thought about it often and I knew that was what I would be sharing with you as I write this article.

**...Mary, mother of Jesus, had an “unplanned pregnancy!” ...**

Yes, I understand that the conception of Jesus was not derived from an act of sin (sex outside of marriage). Luke 1:26-38 tells the incredible story of the immaculate conception of Jesus. Although the circumstances are completely different, I imagine that Mary had a roller coaster of emotions, just like anyone experiencing an unplanned pregnancy.

As Roland shared this story, what he said next resonated with me. He said, God used Mary’s unplanned pregnancy for His good and that should be our first thought when we think about any unplanned pregnancy. That God will use this for His good, to draw those involved closer to Him, just as it did for Mary.

I can relate to the part where Roland said, God used the unplanned pregnancy for His good. I was three months out of high school, eighteen and not married when I found out I was pregnant. My parents were going through a divorce. I was out partying, using drugs and doing everything that I was raised to NOT do, trying to forget what was going on around me and trauma from my past. I was a disaster waiting to happen.



Through my unplanned pregnancy, I gave my life back to God and promised to be the best mom I could be and to raise my baby(ies) to know Him.

The sin was having sex out of wedlock, the baby...a blessing from God that He used for His good. Thirty-four years later and I am still thankful for Danielle, my unplanned blessing.

Mary and Joseph faced a lot of unknowns through their journey, but they trusted God. My goodness...she gave birth to the Son of God! Obviously, there has never been another unplanned pregnancy like the one Mary experienced, however, each story is unique and yet somewhat relatable.

As we hear of those who face unplanned pregnancies, whether it is in our own homes, families, churches, neighbors, friends, or strangers, my hope is that our first thought is not judgement, but that God will use this for His good.

Thank you, precious friends and prayer warriors for standing in the gap for the unborn! Please join us in prayer for 2026, that God will direct those, who, need our services, to our centers and for our team to be the servants that He calls us to be.



# 2025 PMI Financial Status Report

We would like to share with our supporters how your generous contributions are used and to assure you that we are endeavoring to be the Godly stewards we should be.

2025 PMI Year Expenses



This graph shows the estimated year end totals of PMI expenses for the current year which are approximately \$380,000. This estimate is based on the financial reports through the end of October. Following is an explanation of each Expense.

**Staff** Cost of wages and taxes of 9 Employees

**Corporate** Insurances (property/Liability/Health, etc.), Dues for support organizations, website fees, etc.

**Operating** Equipment, printing, postage, software, rents, supplies, utilities, etc.

**Fundraising** Cost of preparing for Events (venues, Banquet meals, etc.)

This year, as of the end of October, we have seen a deficit of contributions in the amount of approximately \$50,000. We can cover the deficit in donations with our savings but it would completely decimate the account. We are trusting the LORD to supply all our needs.

## Client Story

### Babies are a Blessing

Julie and her boyfriend James came to our center seeking a free pregnancy test. Julie explained she believed she was pregnant, but neither she nor James wanted to tell their parents. Both were still living at home and in high school. Julie was sure her mother would kick her out of their home, leaving her with no where to go. James expressed fear about telling his parents for the same reason. As this young couple sat in our office, the anxiety of this pregnancy became very real once their administered pregnancy test came back positive. Our client advocate lovingly sat with them for a couple hours and talked about the importance of not hiding this baby from their parents. She gave them some suggestions on how to share the news of a grandbaby gently with their parents. She gave them truthful information about babies being a blessing, and though it takes some people a little more time to see it, sharing the news of a new baby to their family was important. She even offered to allow this couple to invite their parents into PMI where the couple already felt supported and loved. Eventually this new mom-to-be and dad-to-be, called their parents while still in our PMI office. They explained how sorry they were for disappointing their parents and asked them for forgiveness and help. They shared with their parents that they had found a pregnancy crisis clinic that was willing to also walk beside them in this pregnancy. They thanked us for helping them find the courage to do the next right thing. They appreciated that we took the time to listen to their concerns and shed light on the fact that babies are a blessing!
